

Warden Training

The Warden training is designed to provide the Emergency Control Organisation with the skill, knowledge and experience to perform the duties of a Warden and Floor or Area Warden. It provides knowledge in using human behaviour characteristics during the stressful times associated with an emergency, information on workplace emergency systems operation and communications needs to safely and effectively deal with workplace emergencies.

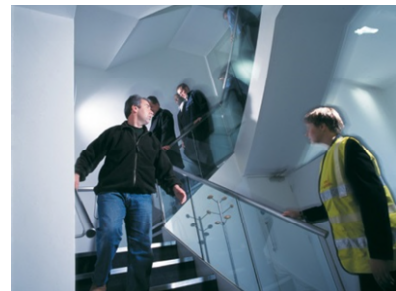
Australian Standard 3745 recommends that the Emergency Control Organization participate in a skills retention activity every 6 months. Participation on the Warden training will assist in compliance with this standard. Chubb also recommends that an evacuation exercise is conducted in conjunction with our Warden training annually to test the response of the Emergency Control Organization.

Duration and Location

This course is delivered in 1 hour. Warden training can be delivered at your premises or at a Chubb training facility.

Content

- Preparation and prevention of emergencies
- Human behaviour during emergencies
- The Emergency Planning Committee
- Responsibilities of the Emergency Control Organisation
- Workplace emergency systems
- Responding to emergencies
